About CCFMG and the University Centers of Excellence

The University Centers of Excellence is the faculty private practice side of Central California Faculty Medical Group. Each physician holds a faculty appointment from the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) at UCSF Fresno. In 1975, the Fresno Medical Education Program was established as a clinical branch of UCSF.

The University Centers of Excellence faculty practice offices were developed to allow the community to have unprecedented access to UCSF faculty physicians.

Patients are now able to receive the same world-class care they expect to receive in larger metropolitan cities without having to travel outside of Fresno.

History

In **1979** Central California Faculty Medical Group, Inc. (CCFMG) became incorporated, changing the physicians from Fresno County salaried employees to a faculty medical group.

In **1984** CCFMG opened the first two private practice sites.

UCSF Fresno Faculty

CCFMG provides faculty for **8** of the **UCSF Fresno residency programs**.

CCFMG provides faculty for **17** of the **UCSF Fresno fellowship subspecialty programs**.

Patient Care

In Fiscal Year 2019* CCFMG recorded **554,914** patient visits.

Community Impact

There are **23 University Centers of Excellence faculty practice sites** throughout the Central Valley in Clovis, Fresno and Visalia.

Since its inception, the UCSF Fresno Medical Education Program has **graduated over 3,000** resident physicians.

There are over **50 different specialties and sub-specialties** offered through the University Centers of Excellence faculty practice locations.

There are over **230+ core faculty physicians** within Central California Faculty Medical Group.

CRMC received **114,025 Emergency Department visits in fiscal year 2018**.

Commitment

Approximately **50%** of graduate physicians **stay** to practice medicine in the Central Valley.
